



Safe Haven Maritime Pte Ltd has a large fully licensed dedicated lay-up anchorage in Batam located conveniently close to Singapore.


Our lay up area is located on the Equator with ideal weather conditions and water depths for lay-up of all types of tonnage.

The environmental condition in our area is ideal for Lay-Up of vessels and Rigs.

There are no adverse weather effects. Typhoons which affect most other areas in Asia are non-existent due to our Lay-Up Area's close proximity to the equator.

Our protected Lay-Up Area ensures limited wave height effects with waves not reaching levels exceeding 1.0-1.5 meters.

There are no swells of any noticeable effect at our Lay-Up Area.

The tide condition at our Lay-Up Area is diurinal ranging within approximately 3.2 meters.

The effects of the current as caused by tide changes can reach about 2.3 knots with direction running SSE/NNW.

Our Lay-Up Area is easily accessible with pilot which will be provided for approach and anchoring operations.





We provide onboard security with four personnel on guard at all times (24 hours). All our personnel are mariners recruited locally minimizing any potential local security threat. Our onboard personnel have fully certified fire fighting certificates.


Our Emergency Response Base is located within line of sight of the presently laid-up vessels and is manned round the clock with a Rapid Response Team. The present response time is 10 minutes.

We have close cooperation with the local Coastguard, Navy, and Marine Police as well as the national Navy, Police and intelligence services who all are available to us.

Our Emergency Response Plans (ERP) covers illegal boarding with strict security and response procedures.

Class will normally suspend International Safety Management Code (ISM) and International Ship and Port Facilities Security Code (ISPS) certificates for vessels laid-up longer than three months with an ISM and ISPS 'reactivation audit' to be performed prior to reactivation.

Safe Haven Maritime Pte Ltd has in place Professional Indemnity Insurance (PII) through ITIC (International Transport Intermediaries Club Ltd of London) covering claims up to US\$ 5 million.






Batam has been steadily growing as an important maritime/offshore repair and new building centre with its close proximity to Singapore and the main East/West shipping routes. Highly qualified low-cost manpower is available in Batam.

Batam has more than 40 shipyards in operation and is a centre for production of offshore oil drilling equipment and platforms. Most major suppliers have office or representatives in Batam ensuring readily available supply of most services and items required for vessel lay-up and reactivation.

Vessel will in general be treated as in-port for H&M insurance with between 15 % and 50% return of calls. (Insurance returns subject to Your insurance policy).
